Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the 19th Street Drainage and Roadway Improvements project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Crystal River, FL located at 123 NW Highway 19, Crystal River, FL 34428. The funding will allow for completion of the design and construction of a rebuilt and hardened roadway that will improve long-term resiliency for the Woodland Estates neighborhood. The project will incorporate proper drainage improvements, roadway widening, hardened shoulders or berms, utility coordination, sidewalk replacement, and appropriate roadway surfacing. These improvements are necessary to restore the roadway and bring it to an acceptable level of service for the neighborhood.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(1); 5305(a)(2); 5305(a)(4); and/or 5305(a)(5).
