I am requesting funding for the City of Brooksville Wastewater Treatment Plant Expansion in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Brooksville, located at 201 Howell Avenue, Brooksville, FL 34601. The funding would be used to address urgent wastewater capacity challenges due to rapid growth. Expansion to treat 5 million gallons daily and a local sewage interconnect is crucial for environmental safety and service sustainability. The project would include construction and the expansion of the wastewater treatment plant. These expansion efforts prioritize community well-being and future growth needs.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Title VI of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C 1381 et seq.
