Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the In-line Chlorine Booster Stations project in fiscal year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Pasco County Board of County Commissioners, care of the Utilities Department, located at 19420 Central Boulevard, Land O' Lakes, Florida 34637. The funding would be used to facilitate compliance with national primary and state drinking water regulations related to chlorine levels. Chlorine booster stations maintain adequate disinfection levels for drinking water that avoids unnecessary disposal of water. These stations will help maintain compliance and protect public health.

The project has a Federal nexus because it is authorized under Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12.
